Nomination Criteria

The PIDS Board of Directors will award a pediatrician with an extensive and distinguished career marked by significant accomplishments and contributions in pediatric infectious diseases including those as a clinician, educator and/or investigator. These accomplishments and contributions are nationally and internationally recognized for their excellence and are in keeping with the Society's purpose to enhance the health of infants, children and adolescents by promoting excellence in diagnosis, management and prevention of infectious diseases through clinical care, education, research and advocacy.

Nomination Process

The awardee is selected by the Board of Directors, from the nominations solicited from the Society's membership by the Nominations and Awards Committee. Any member of the Society in good standing may nominate a candidate. Past nominees that were not selected, can be renominated if they still meet the eligibility criteria. The procedures for nomination are established by the Committee and approved by the Board of Director. The award is given yearly and usually to only one person. Traditionally, the nominee has not been advised of his or her nomination or selection until the announcement at either the PIDS Business Meeting or Annual Dinner.
